

Feeding recommendation: BEWI DOG® puppy comes with a special gravy to facilitate weaning. An especially tasty gravy forms over the food particles when 3 parts BEWI DOG® puppy are mixed with one part warm (40-50°C) water. This stimulates the puppies to accept solid food. Later, BEWI DOG® puppy can also be fed in dry form. Fresh drinking water should be available at all times. Average quantities for feeding puppies and young dogs are listed in the table shown. The correct feeding quantity is best determined by regularly checking the dog's weight. The comparison of the individual weight curve with charts showing orrowt hypical for the breed is recommended.
